The Multimedia Consultant will be facilitating the use of teaching, learning and research technologies, including classroom and lab computers, audio visual and multimedia equipment, and emerging technologies, to support effective teaching and learning. The incumbent will provide technology support in person, via email, phone, and online (e.g., Zoom/Teams). The incumbent will be responsible for training the ITS team, faculty, and staff on academic technology tools and classroom technology systems, including lecture capture systems, video conferencing tools, AR/VR (Augmented reality and virtual reality) tools, simulations/virtual labs, computer lab technology, and with multimedia needs for traditional, hybrid and online teaching. The incumbent will assist with scheduling, training, and support of active learning classrooms and other specialized learning spaces, will facilitate training workshops, and assist with developing online and print documentation, tutorials, and video resources to support these instructional spaces.
